THEME Beautiful Patterns in Nature This photo essay will focus on the endless patterns that nature provides. Whether it is the branching pattern a tree, the spiral swirl of a shell or the perfect ring of petals on a flower, nature is full of patterns for the keen observer. The edge of a leaf may have a scalloped or serrated edge. A bird feather or insect wing reveals checks or stripes. A dog has spots. Can't go outside? Check the fridge! Onions have rings. Lettuce has veins. Mushrooms reveal perfect gills. Get creative and test your photography skills!

The applicant's CUNY ID must be visible in the corner of each photograph (not pasted in--place your ID in the frame before taking the photo).
