Please find attached the Enrollment Management Update for March 1, 2021. In addition to reporting enrollment stats, we are also providing a summary of college-wide efforts to improve enrollment. Feel free to reach out if you have any questions or need more information.

Enrollment:

Below are the registration numbers as of February 26, 2021.

- We have <u>exceeded</u> our revised target of 4800 for the continuing students.
- We have <u>exceeded</u> our target of 500 transfer students.
- We are ahead of where we were for Readmits at this time last year.
- We are closing in on our targets for Freshmen and College Now students.
 - College Now enrollment does <u>not</u> generate FTE's for the college and tends to enroll most of their students <u>after</u> the semester has started.



Efforts to Increase Enrollment

• Open Registration Begins TODAY!!!

- There are over 50 college staff members working together to ensure that students are advised, registered, get their Financial Aid, Bursar and Registrar questions answered. We also have our ASAP, College Discovery, CUNYStart and FLEX areas assisting.

• Admissions Applications

- Admissions has now begun processing applications for Fall 2021. Acceptance letters to early filers were sent on Feb. 23rd.
- The offices continue to work with students to submit documents and finalize incomplete applications.

• Department/Program Collaboration

 Enrollment Management is partnering with the Academic departments to create a Welcome to the (dept) Letter. These letters will focus on providing specific program information as well as inviting students to program specific information sessions. At these sessions new students will have the opportunity to meet with faculty and ask specific questions about the major.

• Vision 2022

- Earlier this year, the Vision 2022 committee began looking at enrollment pipelines, enrollment predictions and enrollment projections. The committee has been charged with creating an Enrollment Management Strategic Plan. The committee has concentrated on looking at high school graduation rates, data for readmit student, adult learners, and our transfer population. During our last session we reviewed and discussed strategic plans from other institutions.
- Recently, I attended the Excelencia in Education webinar hosted by Excelencia. This webinar focused on outreach, recruitment, and retention of LatinX students specifically. Moving forward we will be incorporating a plan to focus on this population.

• Financial Aid

 Of the \$115K in Mellon Funds that were received to help students with outstanding balances, we have \$68K left.
