Due to scheduled construction work on campus by the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY), **Enrollment Management offices will be temporarily moved to rooms U215 and U216 (located off of the Hall of Flags lounge, 2nd floor, U building) effective** <u>July 05, 2022 through August 01, 2022.</u>

The Child Care Center will be closed during the progress of the work. Classes that are already scheduled in the V building will <u>not</u> be relocated.

This work will impact on the LMG High School as well, which will be closed until this project is completed.

DASNY Contractors will be performing intrusive probes along the entire water loop of these two buildings, identifying the areas of leakage, excavating as required, replacing defective piping and restoring the grounds, sidewalks and roadways when completed.

The College is making every effort to mitigate disruption to the College community and to expedite this project so that we may be back to normal as soon as possible. The Contractors will be working every Friday, despite the College being closed.
