Change:

1. Under Required Core, Mathematics and Quantitative Reasoning, the **addition** of MAT 20B0 –Statistics with Algebra

Rationale for Change:

MAT 20B0 (passed at Spring 2023 Curriculum Committee & June 2023 College Council) is a new Statistics corequisite model course, as such, the course is being added as an option under Mathematics and Quantitative Reasoning (MQR) for the A.A.S. Physical Therapist Assistant degree.
