- **Peer Observation Form**
 - The March 2025 revision to the Peer Observation Form to align with RSI was confirmed.
 - Chair is following up to locate the finalized version and clarify how it should be handled to create a fillable version for campus distribution.
- **Optional RSI Checklist**
 - Passed unanimously by the Instruction Committee on May 27, 2025.
 - Determine whether additional steps are needed to distribute this resource to faculty.
- **KCeL RSI Sessions**
 - Confirmed as ongoing. Consider sharing a “quick start” resource for faculty.
- **Grading Schemes & Numeric Equivalencies**
 - Open discussion on the feasibility of creating a shared explanation or guidance document on grading schemes and numeric equivalencies.
 - Consider whether a standardized approach is attainable given the **variability and nuances in syllabi grading practices across the college**.
 - Determine next steps, if any, for developing guidance or recommendations.
- **AI Use Guidelines**
 - New faculty have received the **2024–2025 Faculty Handbook**.
 - Chair will inquire who is responsible for updating the **2025–2026 Faculty Handbook** and whether **aligning AI language with the revised CUNY Academic Integrity Policy** is currently being explored or developed.
 - Committee may consider recommending or supporting language updates once this process is clarified.
