The College Council held a special meeting on December 11, 2020 at 10:00 AM by videoconference. The Agenda was distributed in advance by email and included:

1. Provost Russell will:
 - o explain the CR/NC options 1-3 offered by the University
 - o report on conversations at the College on Mon. 12/7-Tue. 12/8
 - o report on the CUNY Academic Council meeting on this issue on Wed. 12/9
2. Members of the SGA presented their view as students of the best choice for the College
3. Members of the KCC Faculty presented their view as faculty of the best choice for the College
4. Discussion from the floor followed, with Council members making brief statements for or against the available options.
5. All Council members present vote and chose one from Options #1, 2, or 3. The option receiving the most votes of those present ("plurality vote") is the one that was recommended to the President.

The results were as follows:

5 votes for Option #1 - Allow the use of CR/NC grades for all Fall 2020 courses as in the Spring 2020 term

32 votes for Option #2 - Allow the use of CR/NC grades for all Fall 2020 courses except those the college designates to be excluded

12 votes for Option #3 - Do not allow the use of CR/NC grades in Fall 2020 but expand access to the college's existing flexible grading policies.

As per the rules set out in the Agenda, Option #2 was chosen and officially recommended to the President by the College Council.

In the absence of New Business, the meeting adjourned at 11:15 AM.
