

**Program Articulation Agreement between
Adelphi University
And
Kingsborough Community College**

1. Purpose

This agreement between Adelphi University and Kingsborough Community College provides the terms and conditions for students of Kingsborough Community College who have an Associate of Applied Science and seek admission by transfer to the Bachelor's of Science at Adelphi University. The parties will use their best efforts to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

2. Admission

Kingsborough Community College graduates are required to meet the minimum criteria for admission to Adelphi University. At this time, the University requires a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 based upon a maximum GPA of 4.0. for Admission to the College of Nursing and Public Health. In addition, Kingsborough Community College graduates are required to be licensed as a registered nurse in the State of New York or the eligibility for licensure endorsement is required.

Applicants whose GPA falls below a 3.0 will be given individual consideration on a case-by-case basis.

3. Transfer of Credits

Kingsborough Community College students will be eligible to receive up to a maximum of 64 transfer credits at Adelphi University. Only courses completed with a grade of "C-" or higher will be accepted in transfer to the University.

Students who complete the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing at Kingsborough Community College will be responsible for Adelphi University's General Education requirements either with appropriate transfer credits from Kingsborough Community College and/or courses taken at Adelphi University.

4. Scholarships


Academic scholarships range from \$1,500 to \$10,000 plus, based on cumulative G.P.A. and full-time study (part-time scholarships are also available). The minimum cumulative G.P.A. required for an academic scholarship is a 3.0. Need-based financial aid is also available to those who qualify. Priority filing date for **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** is February 15 for fall applicants and October 15 for spring applicants.

5. Terms of Agreement




